

HISTORIC 100 POINTS FOR VIÑEDO CHADWICK

The first Chilean wine to achieve the world's highest recognition

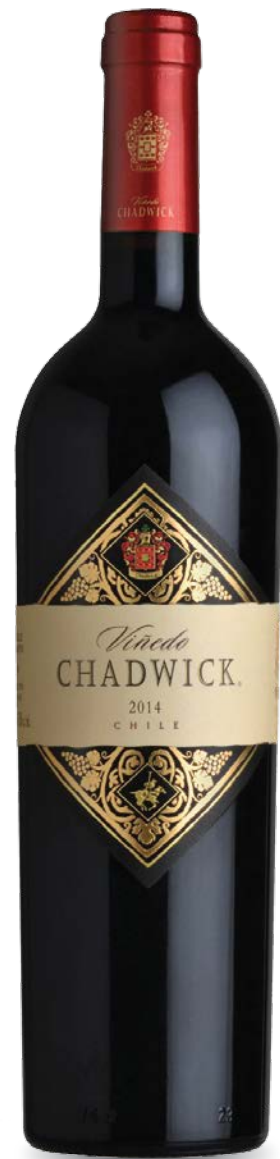

Viñedo Chadwick Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 scored a perfect 100 points, positioning Chile among the most prestigious world-class appellations. This outstanding recognition was published by international wine critic James Suckling, considered the most influential wine critic in the world, who referred to Viñedo Chadwick 2014 as "Chile's first perfect wine and well deserved".

Following his recent visit to Chile, during which he tasted more than 600 wines from different valleys, Suckling published his article entitled "Chile's Evolving Quality Wine World" in which he awarded Viñedo Chadwick 2014 100 points: "Perhaps a sign of Chile truly coming of age is the 100-point rating in this report of the pure Cabernet Sauvignon 2014 Viñedo Chadwick. This is a wine that defines the greatness of Chile with a purity, structure and finesse that competes with the best reds of the world. This is a wine that defines elegance and power at the same time."

Eduardo Chadwick, President of Viñedo Chadwick, commented: "It is the greatest honour to achieve this highest recognition, for our wine and also for Chile. I wish to take this opportunity to thank all our team for its hard work and commitment towards quality all along these years."

Francisco Baettig, Viñedo Chadwick Head Winemaker, adds: "This vintage is perhaps the epitome of purity and freshness of our terroir. I believe it is the greatest expression of Viñedo Chadwick made so far."



OUTSTANDING SCORES FOR LAS PIZARRAS

Las Pizarras Pinot Noir 2015 was recognized with 99 points, while Las Pizarras Chardonnay completes the top 5 wines in Suckling's review with 98 points.



Las Pizarras, the newest iconic project of Viña Errázuriz, had an outstanding performance in the latest report of international wine critic James Suckling. Las Pizarras Pinot Noir 2015 scored 99 points and positioned itself as the Best Pinot Noir in Chile, while Las Pizarras Chardonnay 2015 scored 98 points. Furthermore, both wines were chosen in Suckling's top 5 Picks among 600 Chilean wines tasted, positioning Errázuriz as the only Chilean winery with three wines featuring in the top 5 picks.

According to Suckling, Las Pizarras Pinot Noir 2015 is "even better than the debut and great 2014 vintage (...) Full body yet compacted and compressed giving it an ultra-fine palate profile (...) Polished to almost perfection. Seamless finish."

About Las Pizarras Chardonnay 2015, Suckling wrote: "The structure and length of this white highlights its greatness. Full body, yet tight and structured with a superb linear backbone of ripe fruit and fine phenolic tension (...) All about refined texture."

"We wanted to do the best possible Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from the place", states Francisco Baettig, "we wanted to push Aconcagua Costa as the origin, and the place, Pizarras, was created with a terroir approach. The name of the wine is directly related to the place, the terroir, and it is not just a fantasy name", adds to trace the core ideal of Las Pizarras.

In the latest report by James Suckling, Viña Errázuriz's icon wines demonstrated once again their outstanding quality and consistency, achieving highlighted scores. Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve 2014 was praised with 96 points, and described as "very cool black currant and blackberry aromas with hints of flowers. Full body, pretty integrated tannins and a bright and fruity finish. Hints of walnuts and berries on the finish. Chocolate undertone." Don Maximiano 2014 is a blend of 68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Carmenere, 9% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot.

Kai Carmenera 2014 was scored with 96 points, maintaining the high quality level displayed in Suckling's previous tastings in Chile.

Kai was described as "a wine with focus and spice, blackberry and dark chocolate. Black licorice and oyster. Full body, super supple tannins and a savory finish. Gorgeous rich style that has tension. 95% Carmenere and 5% Syrah."

Finally, the 92 points for Syrah La Cumbre 2014 rounded up the outstanding participation of Errázuriz's icon wines in the latest Chile report by James Suckling.
